2027 Vendor/Exhibitor Rules and Regulations

All vendors/exhibitors agree to and acknowledge these Rules and Regulations:

1. Regulation Enforcement

North Pole Cornerstones (“the Management”) retains full authority to interpret, enforce, and amend all rules and regulations governing the School. Any amendments or subsequent communications issued by the Management are binding upon all Vendors/Exhibitors. Matters not specifically addressed within these regulations fall solely under the discretion of the Management, and Vendors/Exhibitors agree to abide by all such decisions. Vendors/Exhibitors who violate these rules may be removed from the event and may forfeit the opportunity to exhibit in future years.

2. Exhibit Space Assignment

Exhibit booth spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Should circumstances beyond the Management’s control require relocating a Vendor/Exhibitor, the Management will make every effort to place the Vendor/Exhibitor in a location that serves their best interest and will provide notice of the change. All space allocations are made at the sole discretion of the Management. Vendors/Exhibitors may not sublease their assigned space, in whole or in part.

3. Exhibit Space Specifications

The Management will determine the dimensions of each Vendor/Exhibitor space. Total space allotted to any participant may be limited based on overall booth availability and the number of companies wishing to exhibit. Although the Management will make every effort to accommodate requested space, vendors and exhibitors are not guaranteed to receive the full amount of space they request.

4. Eligible Displays

The Management reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the exposition. Live animals may be included in an exhibit provided they meet all interstate and intrastate health requirements, as well as all City and Oklahoma State health regulations. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring proper care and maintenance of any animals included in their display.

5. Code of Conduct

All vendors and their representatives agree to conduct themselves with the highest standards of integrity and respect toward attendees, fellow vendors, event staff, and guests.
